— RULES & REGULATIONS —

The Blair County Dog Park is a 'Members Only' Park

Rules and regulations are designed for the health and safety of all dogs and owners. All rules will be strictly enforced. Those not respecting the rules may lose their membership privileges and fees paid will not be refunded.

- An application must be completed by the dog's owner and Park Pass membership fee must be paid in full for admission into the park. Required record of vaccination must be submitted at the time of application.
- Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and injuries caused by them.
- USE COMMON SENSE! Do not go to the park on bad weather days. This is dangerous and damages the road and park turf.
- Dogs must be licensed, have current Rabies, DA2PP (DHPP) vaccines and be healthy and free of fleas and parasites.
- Male dogs over the age of 10 months must be neutered. Females in season are not permitted into the park.
- Puppies younger than 4 months of age are not be permitted into the park.
- Only 2 dogs per person will be permitted into the fenced enclosures per visit.
- Owners must clean up after their own dogs. This means poop both inside and outside the gated areas. No exceptions.
- Dogs showing aggressive behavior (including bullying, biting, nipping, excessive growling) will be removed from the park and may be required to attend behavior training and pass an assessment test before permitted to return.
- Owners must supervise their dog(s) at all times. Unattended dogs may be removed from the park and impounded by the local animal control authorities.
- Children under the age of 12 (including babies) will not be permitted to enter the fenced areas of the dog park. This is not a playground. Children must not run in the park. Children's toys are not permitted in the fenced in areas of the park.
- No food or treats (or tug toys or toys infused with food or treats IE: Kongs) are permitted inside the fenced areas of the park. No human food or drinks are permitted inside the park. (Food and drinks permitted at the designated picnic areas outside the fenced area.)
- Dogs must be unleashed within the holding area of the double-gated entry before entering the park and leashed prior to leaving the park. Dogs are not permitted to be on a leash in the fenced in areas.
- Members may not bring in "guest dogs" without going through the registration process.
- All trash must be placed in the provided trash receptacles. Take home what you bring (water jugs/bowls/toys/etc.) and take nothing you didn't bring to the park.
- Dog owners should keep their Membership ID card in their car and present it to groundskeeper or another member if requested.
- Members may run their dogs off leash outside of the fenced area (within the park parameters) at their own risk.
- Violators of any of the rules above will be subject to removal from the park and suspension of park privileges.

The Board of Directors of the Blair County Dog Park Association reserves the right to make changes and alterations to these rules at any time.
